# **WA Minimum Wage 2008**

The WAIRC is obliged before 1 July 2008 to set a minimum wage under the *WA Minimum Conditions of Employment Act* for adults, apprentices and trainees AND to adjust the wage rates in state awards and to set a statement of principles to be applied by the Commission when setting wages.

The General Order to be issued will apply to those employers and employees covered by the WA industrial relations system.

The Commission will convene public hearings on Monday, 19 and Tuesday, 20 May 2008 and the rest of that week if necessary at 10:30am each day in Court 3 (floor 18) to hear from persons who wish to make a submission.

Any person who wishes to appear and make a submission at the hearing should notify the Registrar of the Commission stating the basis of their interest by Friday, 25 April 2008.

Any person who wishes to make a written submission and not appear should do so in writing or by email by Friday, 25 April 2008. Please note that copies of written submissions may be made available to parties appearing at the hearing. The proceedings will be webcast.
