APPLICATION FOR ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 72A(2) OF THE INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS ACT 1979 FOR THE RIGHT OF AN ORGANISATION TO REPRESENT THE INDUSTRIAL INTERESTS OF ALL OUTSIDE EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED BY THE CITY OF ROCKINGHAM

NOTICE is given that an application has been made to the Commission in Court Session by the Western Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union of Employees pursuant to section 72A of the Industrial Relations Act 1979 (WA). The Western Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union of Employees seeks an order of the Commission in Court Session pursuant to section 72A(2)(a) of the Industrial Relations Act 1979 (WA) that the Western Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union of Employees has the right, to the exclusion of the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union of Workers, to represent the industrial interests of all outside employees employed in the enterprise of the City of Rockingham who are eligible for membership of the Western Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union of Employees. Alternatively, the Western Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union of Employees seeks an order of the Commission in Court Session pursuant to section 72A(2)(c) of the *Industrial Relations Act 1979* (WA) that the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union of Workers does not have the right to represent the industrial interests of outside employees employed in the enterprise of the City of Rockingham who are eligible for membership of the organisation.

This matter will be listed for hearing before the Commission in Court Session on a date to be fixed, which is not to be before the expiration of 30 days from the day on which this notice is first published.

This application may be inspected by appointment at Level 17, 111 St Georges Terrace, Perth by any interested person without charge.

Pursuant to regulation 73(2) of the *Industrial Relations Commission Regulations 2005* (WA) any person who wishes to be heard in relation to this application must lodge an application on a *Form 1A – Multipurpose Form* at least 10 days before the hearing of the section 72A application and set out in detail the grounds on which the person claims sufficient interest to be heard in relation to this application.
