## REVIEW OF SCOPE CLAUSES OF AWARDS UNDER SECTION 37D OF THE INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS ACT 1979 (WA)

Notice is given of an application on the motion of the Western Australian Industrial Relations Commission to review the scope clauses of the *Building Trades Award 1968* with a view to varying the award in accordance with s 37D of the *Industrial Relations Act 1979*.

Sections 37D(1) to (4) provides that the Commission may vary the scope of private sector awards of its own motion as follows:

- (1) Except as provided in this section, the Commission may vary the scope of a private sector award of its own motion.
- (2 A variation must not be made in relation to
  - (a) an application under section 50(2) that does not seek the variation of the scope of the private sector award; or
  - (b) a State Wage order under section 50A.
- (3) A variation must specify that the scope of the private sector award extends to and binds
  - (a) employers of a class or classes specified in the award, whether or not the employers are also specified by name in the award; and
  - (b) employees
    - (i) of employers referred to in paragraph (a); and
    - (ii) of a class or classes specified in the award.
- (4) For the purposes of subsection (3)(a) and (b)(ii), the class may be described by reference to
  - (a) a particular industry or part of an industry; or
  - (b) a particular kind of work.
