<u>13 – LIFE MEMBERSHIP</u>

(1) Conference may confer life membership of the Union upon a financial member having not less than twenty-five continuous<u>fifteen</u> years of membership of the Union whom Conference considers merits life membership by reason of long years of active and faithful service to the Union.
